Application Process

A \$50.00 *non-refundable* application fee is due upon receipt of this application. Upon acceptance to the program, tuition is also non-refundable.

By enrolling your child in a cooperative nursery school, you are not only seeking a safe and happy place for your child, you are expressing a desire to share in your child's school experience. Toward that end, you will be required to parent help in your child's classroom and to choose one "work bank" job.

I understand and am willing and able to fulfill all my obligations as a member of this cooperative. I further understand that I must submit a \$50.00 application fee, which is non-refundable, as is the tuition, should I withdraw my child.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Three Year Old Programs

- Two classes of 12 children each: *a two-day class with a third day option*, comprised of the younger birthdays, and *a three day class*, comprised of the older birthdays.
- Lunch Bunch, an extended day option is available on Monday and Tuesday for two hours after the end of the regular school day.

Pre-K Programs

Four Year Old Programs

- Two classes of 12 children each.
- Lunch Bunch, an extended day option, is available on Wednesday and/or Thursday for two hours after the end of the regular school day.
- Construction Club, an extended day program option, available on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and/or Thursday until 3:00 p.m. after the end of the regular school day, with a lottery, if needed.

AM/PM Four/Five Year Old Programs

- Two classes of 12 children each: *one morning class, one afternoon class*. This class is designed for students who have completed the four year old program, but are not attending kindergarten.
- Lunch Bunch, an extended day option for AM classes, available on Monday, Wednesday and/or Thursday for two hours after the end of the regular school day. Snack Bunch, an extended day option for our PM class before class begins, available on Monday and/or Tuesday.
- Construction Club, an extended day program option for AM classes, available on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and/or Thursday until 3:00 p.m. after the end of the regular school day, with a lottery, if needed.

If the demand is greater than the available space in any class, a lottery will be held, with first priority given to current or former NCNS families. New applicants are enrolled based on availability.

In addition, NCNS has adopted the policy of a “natural progression” in regards to our programs. The natural progression, once a child is enrolled at NCNS, is as follows:

- * the *3 year old classes* move to the 4 year old classes the following year;
- * the *4 year old classes* either leave for kindergarten or move to the 4/5 year classes, with a lottery, if needed.

When a lottery is necessary, natural progression takes priority.

Changes in enrollment may require that class assignments be adjusted.

* The Winchester Public Schools require that any child entering Kindergarten **must** be 5 years old by September 1st of that particular school year.
